



# SUPPLY LIST

## 2025-2026

Below is a list of general school supplies. Extra supplies may be requested by the teacher as each teacher runs his/her classroom slightly differently.

**\*\* All students will need to bring the following items below regardless of grade level\*\***

- Spill Proof water bottle-NO Stanley or straw cups
  - 3 boxes of Kleenex
  - 1 bottle of Hand Sanitizer
  - 3 containers of Clorox Wipes

---

### Primary (Grades K–2)

- Backpack to fit school supplies and Memoria Press Student Guides
- School box, snap shut (8"x 5") and labeled with your child's first and last name.

Fill the school box with the following—each item below needs to be labeled with first and last name or initials:

- 1 pack of 24 Crayola Crayons
- 1 pack of 24 Crayola Colored Pencils, sharpened
- Scissors (metal blade, pointed)
- 4 glue sticks
- 2 pink erasers
- 2 dry erase markers— thin tip, preferably black (First/Second Grade)

- 4 sharpened Ticonderoga Yellow "My First Ticonderoga" Pencils (Kindergarten)
- 8 sharpened Ticonderoga pencils (First/Second Grade)

- KinderMat or beach towel (Kindergarten only; used for rest time and kept at school)
- Crayola 8-color "Education" Watercolor Set (labeled with child's name)
- 1 folder (for sending work home/to school)
- 12-inch ruler (wood or metal, labeled with child's name)
- Small whiteboard for student use in class and at home (no larger than 9" x 12")
- Old sock to use as white board eraser

## **Grammar School (Grades 3–6)**

- Backpack to fit 3-ring binder and Memoria Press Student Books
- 1 pack of Wide Rule (3rd and 4th Grade) or College Rule (5th and 6th Grade) loose leaf paper
- 1 white 1.5 inch 3-ring binder with clear view cover
- 1 pack of Avery 8-tab Plastic Binder Dividers with Pockets (LABELED: Latin, Classical, Literature, Composition, Science, Math, Geography. The 8th tab will be empty.)
- 1 folder (for sending work home/to school)
- Pencil box or pouch
- 1-24 pack Crayola colored pencils, sharpened
- 1 yellow highlighter
- Sharpened Ticonderoga pencils
- 2 red pens
- 2 dry erase markers (thin tip, preferably black)
- 1 one-subject spiral notebook for each subject: Latin, Classical Studies, Literature, Science, Spelling
- Graph paper spiral notebook (for Math only)
- 12-inch ruler (wood or metal)
- Scissors (metal blade, pointed)
- Small whiteboard for student use in class (no larger than 9" x 12")
- Old sock to use as an eraser
- 1 package of index cards
- 1 plastic index card box (individual 3"x5"x1")

## **Upper Grades (Grades 7-8)**

- Four 3-ring solid color binders.
  - Two (1.5-inch 3 ring binder)
  - Two (1 inch 3 ring binder)
  - 4 packs of dividers w/tabs (no pockets)
- Pens (red, blue, and black)
- Pencils and erasers
- Highlighters
- Colored Pencils (12-24)
- Loose leaf ruled notebook paper- 2 packages
- Clear plastic ruler with metric scale
- Protractor
- 3 Thin Black Dry erase markers
- Old sock to use as an eraser
- 2 pkg loose leaf 4x4 graph paper

\*Graphing is introduced in 8th grade, but graphing calculators are not required until high school.
